General Information

Illustrative Agreement

This Illustrative Agreement is between an illustrator and an individual who requests that the illustrator create images for a written work such as a children's book, textbook and how-to book. This agreement sets out the specifics of the arrangement including the details of the project, delivery schedule and how much the illustrator will be paid. It also contains a copyright grant of rights and ownership of original artwork provisions.

It is imperative that this type of agreement be memorialized in a clear and concise manner. A well-written Illustrative Agreement will prove invaluable in the event there are questions or misunderstandings as to who holds the right and title to any illustrations contained within a work.

Instructions and Checklist

Illustrative Agreement

Both parties must read the agreement carefully.
Insert all requested information in the spaces provided on the form.
Read the "Grant of Rights" and "Ownership of Original Artwork" provisions carefully. If they are complicated or ambiguous, please set out examples to ensure they are clearly understood.
Read the "Price" and "Payment Schedule " provisions carefully and review the payment structure to ensure it is correct.
This form contains the basic terms and language that should be included in similar agreements.
Both the illustrator and recipient must sign the agreement.
Both parties should retain either an original or copy of the signed agreement.
All legal documents should be kept in a safe location such as a fireproof safe or safe deposit box.
